## Performance plan

All EU countries will develop performance plans for air navigation services in order to bring about improvements and streamlining in air navigation services in Europe.

According to EU regulations, all EU countries must produce performance plans for air navigation services. The first reference period (RP1) was 3 years from

1 January 2012 to 31 December 2014, the second reference period (RP2) is 5 years from 1 January 2015 to 31 December 2019, the third reference period (RP3) is 5 years from 1 Jan 2020 to 31 Dec 2024 and the fourth reference period (RP4) is 5 years from 1 Jan 2025 to 31 Dec 2029.

The purpose of the regulation and the development of performance plans is to bring about improvements and streamlining in air navigation services in Europe. The European Commission sets targets at EU level and Member States set national targets or targets for functional airspace blocks that contribute to meeting EU targets.
